I encourage our prayer groups to regularly give out copies of the CCCR Vision Statement, which we have in English and Spanish pamphlets (available at the Center or we can email copies to you). The pamphlet also gives an explanation of the 5 major focuses of Catholic Charismatic Renewal.

The Vision Statement says that we foster a grace for renewal.

- **A Grace for Renewal in the Holy Spirit:** The dynamic grace of baptism in the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:5), which empowered the members of the early Church at Pentecost. Baptism in the Holy Spirit is an adult affirmation and renewal of the graces of the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Pope Francis, and Pope Benedict before him, have stated that the grace of baptism in the Spirit is meant for the whole Church.
- **A Lifestyle in the Holy Spirit:** A relationship and lifestyle in the Holy Spirit where we depend daily on our Advocate for love, inspiration, guidance, wisdom, growth in holiness, empowerment, and spiritual gifts for building up the Body of Christ (service and evangelization).

Pope Francis has called Charismatic Renewal “a current of grace of the Holy Spirit being poured out for the renewal of the Church in our time.” The pope has made CHARIS (Catholic Charismatic International Services) part of the Vatican Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life (one of the Vatican’s departments).

It is important that we give people a good, clear explanation of Charismatic Renewal that is based in Scripture and Catholic Church teaching. ***We are glad to come to prayer groups to teach on these areas.***

Animo a nuestros grupos de oración a que distribuyan regularmente copias de la Declaración de la Visión del CCCR, que tenemos en folletos en inglés y español (disponibles en el Centro o podemos enviarle copias por correo electrónico). El folleto también explica los 5 enfoques principales de la Renovación Carismática Católica.

La Declaración de la Visión dice que fomentamos ambas cosas:

- **Una Gracia para la Renovación en el Espíritu Santo:** La gracia dinámica del bautismo en el Espíritu Santo (Hechos 1:5), que empoderó a los miembros de la Iglesia primitiva en Pentecostés. El bautismo en el Espíritu Santo es una afirmación adulta y una renovación de las gracias de los Sacramentos del Bautismo y la Confirmación. El Papa Francisco, y el Papa Benedicto antes que él, han declarado que la gracia del bautismo en el Espíritu está destinada a toda la Iglesia.
- **Un estilo de vida en el Espíritu Santo:** Una relación y estilo de vida en el Espíritu Santo donde dependemos diariamente de nuestro Abogado para el amor, la inspiración, la guía, la sabiduría, el crecimiento en la santidad, el empoderamiento y los dones espirituales para edificar el Cuerpo de Cristo (servicio y evangelización).

El Papa Francisco ha llamado a la Renovación Carismática “una corriente de gracia del Espíritu Santo derramada para la renovación de la Iglesia en nuestro tiempo”. El Papa ha hecho que CHARIS (Servicios Católicos Carismáticos Internacionales) forme parte del Dicastery del Vaticano para los Laicos, la Familia y la Vida (uno de los departamentos del Vaticano).

Es importante que le demos a la gente una explicación buena y clara de la Renovación Carismática que se base en las Escrituras y la enseñanza de la Iglesia Católica. ***Nos complace venir a grupos de oración para enseñar sobre estas áreas.***
